Overview

Once again, as part of the SJSU Salzburg Program, International & Extended Studies is inviting applications from interested undergraduate students to participate in the SJSU Salzburg Scholars Program during 2008-2009. This is a unique opportunity for students to broaden your awareness of global issues and enhance the greater good of the University through participation in a short-term study abroad experience in Salzburg, Austria.

SJSU Scholars Program

Students who are selected to serve as SJSU Salzburg Scholars will attend an intensive week-long session of the Salzburg Global Seminar's International Study Program in Global Citizenship during the week of first week of June, 2008 (5/31-6/7/07). They are also required to spend the next school year working as a group with SJSU Salzburg Fellows (faculty and administrators) to share what they have learned and help globalize the campus as a whole. SJSU Scholars will enroll in a 3-credit course in Spring 2008 (Wed nights) and enroll in a 3-credit independent study during the 2008-2009 academic year to support their participation in a mentoring program, through which they will work closely with an SJSU Salzburg Fellow on an applied project.

San Jose State intends to appoint 10-15 SJSU Salzburg Scholars in 2008-2009 from all seven of its colleges and welcomes applications from full-time students who are in good standing at the University. Program expenses will be approximately \$2,500-\$3,000 per Scholar, which covers the session fee and travel costs to Salzburg. SJSU expects to provide full scholarships for at least 10 students and anticipates that there may be additional support from other SJSU sources for the remaining positions.

Application Procedures

Students interested in becoming a SJSU Salzburg Scholar in 2008 should complete all of the following application documents and submit them together in a single application package:

- [1] Application Form for this program
- [2] Statement of Purpose (250-500 words) explaining why you would like to become a SJSU Salzburg Scholar, what attributes and achievements qualify you for this position, and how you might contribute to internationalizing SJSU as a member of this group.
- [3] Two Recommendation Forms (at least one from a current SJSU faculty member)

The deadline for application packages is Monday, 26 November 2007

The Selection Committee will announce its decision by the end of the Fall 2007 semester.
